Project Overview

In 2019, Inglewood will see the replacement of its aging collector and local roadway surfaces, streetlights, and sidewalks as part of the City of Edmonton's Neighbourhood Renewal program for mature neighbourhoods.

Planning for this renewal has just begun. A new dedicated City branch, Building Great Neighbourhoods, will also explore the redevelopment of other City owned areas within the community, including green spaces and parks, and look for opportunities and funding to make desired upgrades and enhancements in coordination with the Neighbourhood Renewal program.

Building Great Neighbourhoods

Neighbourhoods are special places where we live, socialize, and raise our families. Every neighbourhood is unique, made up of a special mix of long-term residents, newcomers, and families of all shapes and sizes.

Neighbourhoods are where we go to school, practice our faith, relax in the park, and catch the bus to work. They represent not only where we live, but how we live.

In time, neighbourhoods grow old and require improvements. Building Great Neighbourhoods is designed to increase vibrancy and improve infrastructure in Edmonton's neighbourhoods, for example roadways and sidewalks. It takes a holistic approach to making changes beyond infrastructure improvements, working in partnership with residents to focus on what they want to see.

April 2018	Public Workshops, Online and Hardcopy Survey <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Inform public of the draft project vision and important elements, and gather input to refine them- Gather input on community assets and design priorities
Summer/Fall 2018	Public Online Survey <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Inform public of draft renewal plan and gather input to refine it
Fall 2018	Public Engagement Session <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Inform public of survey results- Gather additional input to further refine the renewal plan
Winter 2019	Pre-Construction Communication <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Inform public of final renewal plans, sidewalk local improvement process and what to expect during construction
Spring 2019 to Fall 2021	Construction <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Construction in the neighbourhood will be staged over three years
