Dear Home Owner.

If you are receiving this letter, your property resides along the Metro Line NW alignment and has been chosen as a site to participate in a noise and vibration study that will assess conditions in advance of design and construction of the Metro Line NW LRT expansion. The data that is collected will play an important role in understanding current conditions along this future LRT alignment.

The work will begin on Tuesday, September 5, 2017 and will be completed by Friday, September 15, 2017. The process will involve members of our team placing monitoring equipment on select residential properties to collect information. The data collection will take minimum of 24 hours but no longer than 48 hours, at which time the equipment will be collected. In some cases, a member of our team will need to go into a yard to set up and/or lock the equipment to a fence or a tree. All areas will be returned to their original condition when the work is completed.

All work will take place Monday – Friday from 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. There will be no noise or vibration associated with the activity.
