Strathcona's neighbourhood renewal has begun!

In 2019, Strathcona will see the replacement of its aging collector and local roadway surfaces, streetlights, and sidewalks as part of the City of Edmonton's Neighbourhood Renewal program for mature neighbourhoods. Planning for this renewal has just begun and is the focus for a new dedicated City branch, **Building Great Neighbourhoods**. The redevelopment of other City-owned areas within the community, including green spaces and parks will also be explored. Alleys and arterial roads are not part of this work.
