# DOOR ZONE

The Door Zone is a 1 m (3ft.) area along the side of a parked car where an opening door can hit and seriously injure a cyclist.



Cyclists

When riding beside parked cars, even if you are in a bike lane, ride on the left side of the lane-away from the parked cars.

Try to look inside each parked car before you pass. If you're unable to see if someone is inside, or if you spot someone inside, move outside the Door Zone or slow down and pass carefully.



Drivers

When parked on the side of the road do a shoulder check, over your left shoulder, before opening your door to ensure there are no oncoming cyclists.

Opening the door with your right hand will remind you to do a shoulder check.

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
