STRATHCONA IS GETTING A FACELIFT

Strathcona's neighbourhood renewal has begun! The neighbourhood's aging road surfaces, sidewalks and light standards are scheduled to be replaced in 2019, excluding arterial roads or alleys. Other opportunities to improve parks and public spaces will also be explored.

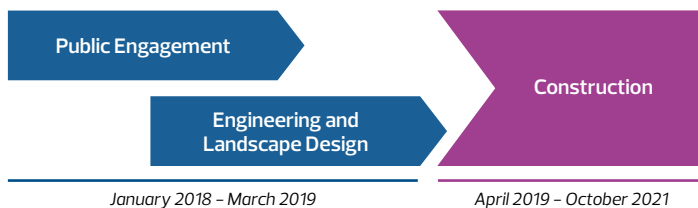
THE NEIGHBOURHOOD-LED STRATHCONA WORKING COMMITTEE
