2. Request to name an Indigenous art park within Queen Elizabeth Park.

Motion: Squair, McDonald

That the Naming Committee approves the name as **ᐱᓄᓐ (ÎNÎW) River Lot 11 ∞** for the Indigenous art park located within Queen Elizabeth Park.

As described in the naming application, the name speaks to the stories of this land from the First Nations and Metis perspective. ÎNÎW means “I am of the earth” and is preceded by the Cree syllabics. River Lot 11 refers to Metis settler Joseph McDonald, the first settler on the south side of the river. The “∞” symbol represents the Metis Nation and is shown on the Metis national flag.

3. Request to name a lane near 82 (Whyte) Avenue NW.
