1. Welcome and Introductions

- Roger Jevne opened the meeting at 6:10pm. Introductions were made and Julie Stormer and Charlene Roche from Civic Events and Partnerships were introduced to provide a very preliminary High Level Oilers Playoffs 2019 programming picture
- Edmonton Oilers 2019 Playoffs will be similar to last 2017 playoffs using Ford Hall for Oiler Watch Parties and an expansion onto 104th Avenue. Play off party to start 1-2 hrs before game and end after the game is over.

- REACH Edmonton comment: Crisis 24/7 van will start 1 hour before games and 1 hour after games so please do not hesitate to use the call in.
- Each round of the play offs could include more road closures. Coordinated services with OEG, EPS, Roads, Fire/Ambulance and Civic Events will ensure a safe and family friendly environment
- Tentative programming to include: Big screens viewing, beer gardens, vendors, family friendly zone, Edmonton tourism
- Public Washrooms will be placed on site

2. Terms of Reference Review / Arena District Local Advisory Committee (ADLAC)

- Added under community maximizing benefits you will find the partnership with Katz Group and the City of Edmonton. During construction of Rogers Place the focus was on employment and hospitality and since then parking, community arena programming and other neighbourhood impacts have been brought up. This Committee continues to be a place to share information and we will make sure that concerns are either dealt with here at this table or moved and followed up with other committees that are already established.
- Roger reviewed each point of the ADLAC and allows for comments from committee members
- Under Composition a discussion came up to expand the Committee to include a McEwan University representative. All committee members present felt this was a good idea and approved. **Action:** Darrell Nordell to connect with McEwan University and ask for a representative to join the Committee.
- Chart below represents some of the other discussion points under TOR Purpose of Committee and follow up. Committee members felt that although Rogers Place may or may not cause some of these issues that as visitors come to the Downtown and to experience Rogers Place that a safe and inviting community is needed.
- Stu Ballantyne comments: We are also in this community as neighbours and similar issues also arise in Rogers Place itself.

Parking	Darrell Nordell to connect with Parking services and enforcement around Rogers Place parking during events and non events with McEwan students, Downtown visitors and Royal Alex hospital having impacts on community.
	Follow up: Darrell Nordell to follow up with Parking Bylaw Enforcement around cars parking over the allotted 2hr time limit.
	Follow up: February 6th - Talked to Parking assets with City of Edmonton and currently a Residential Parking Program is not being considered for area North of Rogers Place to 108th Avenue in Central McDougall. Reason given: Amount of apartment residents vs the number of on street stalls is very unequal.
Community Crime and Disorder	Darrell Nordell to continue to work with NET team on Central McDougall Crime and Disorder.
	Follow up: Edmonton Police Service to attend upcoming Central McDougall Executive meeting. NET initiatives are also on going.
Safe Consumption Sites	Darrell Nordell to follow up with Safe Consumption Site task team that is currently set up and meeting with stakeholders that include community, agencies and business associations in the area
	Follow up: Connected with chair for Safe Consumption Site task team and expressed Arena District stakeholder concerns that are being observed from Safe Consumption Sites. Meeting is coming up in March and will be discussed further at the committee table.
