Where a project has a General Contractor, trade permit coordination through a Building Permit is usually required. Trade permits will be issued in conjunction with the Building Permit. For Building Permit application status, contact the General Contractor or building owner. Every compulsory trade contractor must be registered with Safety Codes Permits and Inspections Section of the City of Edmonton. Safety Codes Officers entering any worksite (including occupied homes) are required to wear approved footwear for safety reasons.
