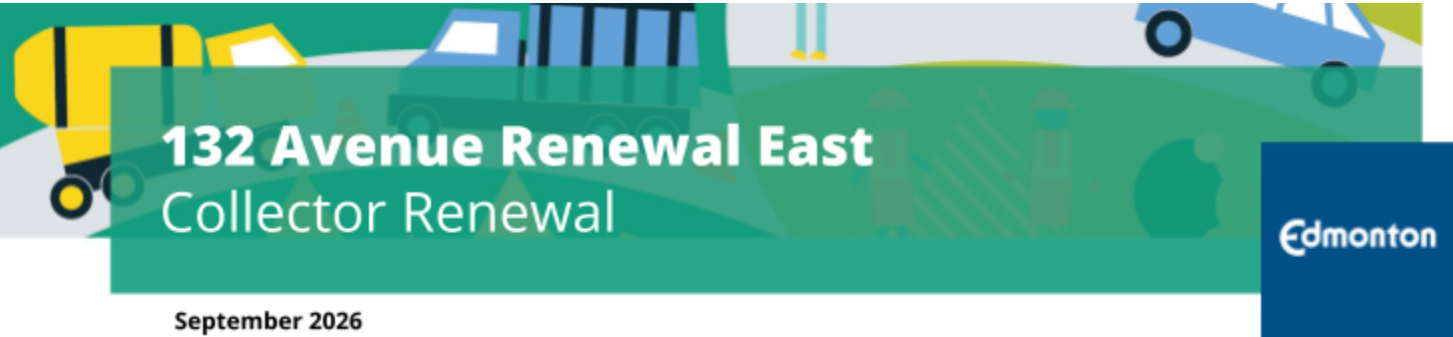

132 AVENUE EAST COLLECTOR RENEWAL SCHOOL BULLETIN

Year 3 of 132 Avenue Collector Renewal construction continues.

Once complete, 132 Avenue will include one lane of traffic in each direction with a repaved road, widened sidewalks and new active transportation lanes. This ensures all Edmontonians can use 132 Avenue safely, whether they're walking, biking, rolling or driving.

Construction update

Construction is complete in front of St. Matthew Catholic Elementary School!

132 Avenue between 86 Street and 90 Street is now open, with one lane of traffic in each direction. Construction continues on 132 Avenue between 82 Street and 86 Street.

It's important to note, while construction continues between 82 Street and 86 Street, vehicle traffic must access 132 Avenue via 90 Street, 88 Street or 86 Street.

Please see the detour map below for access information during this stretch of construction.

The sidewalk is complete and open for use from 97 Street to 82 Street.

While access to the school is maintained, the closure may result in additional traffic congestion in the area. It is recommended to leave extra travel time or use active mode options and public transportation.

Full access to 132 Avenue between 82 Street and 90 Street is expected to be restored by the end of October.

BUS DETOURS

School bus loading area(s) (marked in yellow on the map) remain in the current locations in front of the school throughout construction.

During construction, a number of ETS and school special routes will be detoured around the construction site. A temporary bus stop (marked in dark blue on the map) will be available for the School Special routes on the east side of 90 Street, between 132 Avenue and 133 Avenue. ACCESS IMPACTS

To keep everyone safe during construction, the Project Team asks you to:

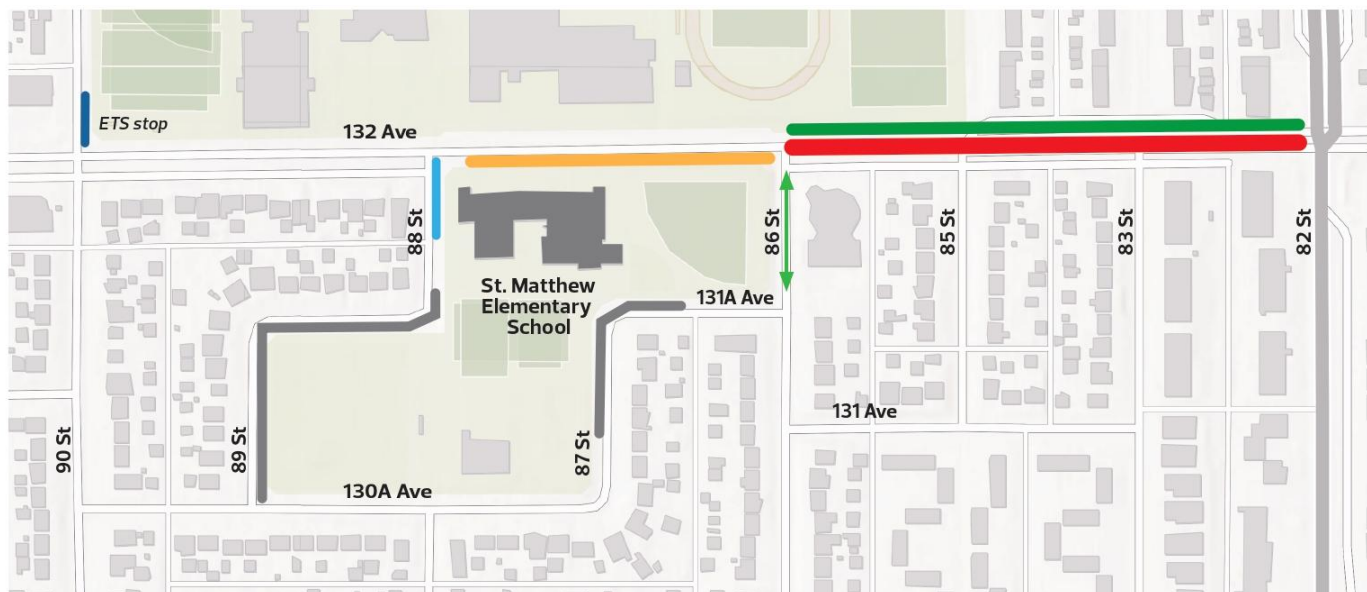
- Follow all signage and any site crew directions
- Drop children off from the passenger side of the vehicle
- Do not stop in driving lanes or crosswalks
- Use designated drop-off and pick-up zones, when available (identified on the map below)
- Find parking away from 132 Avenue, where possible, to assist with pick up and drop offs

Street parking, shown in grey on the map, is available for pick up and drop off along 88 Street, between 132 Avenue and 131 A Avenue, along 131 A Avenue, between 88 Street and 89 Street and along 89 Street, between 131 A Avenue and 130 A Avenue. The intersection at 88 Street and 132 Avenue has reopened. As a reminder, 88 Street is a one-way street for northbound traffic only. You cannot turn left onto 132 Avenue from 88 Street.

A zone for those with accessibility needs is shown in light blue on the map. This zone is just west of the school, along 88 Street and between 132 Avenue and 131A Avenue. This zone can be accessed via 89 Street from 130A Avenue.
