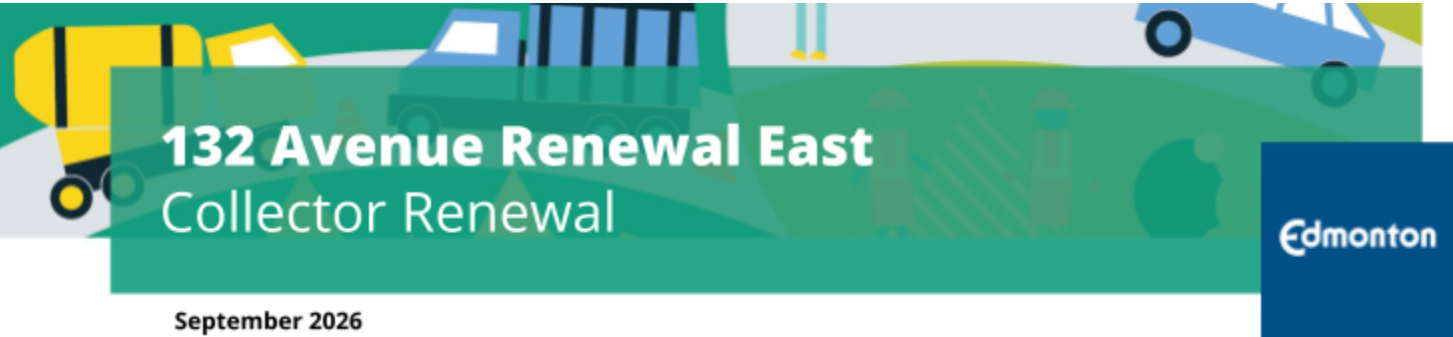

132 AVENUE EAST COLLECTOR RENEWAL SCHOOL BULLETIN

Year 3 of 132 Avenue Collector Renewal construction continues.

Once complete, 132 Avenue will include one lane of traffic in each direction with a repaved road, widened sidewalks, parking bays and new active transportation lanes. This ensures all Edmontonians can use 132 Avenue safely, whether they're walking, biking, rolling or driving.

The Project Team is committed to keeping community members informed during construction. Updates on construction will be posted at edmonton.ca/132Avenue. You can also sign up for email updates on the web page.

Construction update

While construction in front of St. Vladimir Catholic Elementary School is complete, 132 Avenue is now closed between 82 Street and Delwood Road. This closure allows crews to complete the 132 Avenue connection across 82 Street. Construction on 132 Avenue between 90 Street and Delwood Road is expected to be complete in late fall 2026.

While this closure impacts access to St. Vladimir from 82 Street, it does not impact any existing pick-up/drop-off areas or school bus loading zones.

ACCESS IMPACTS

The map below shows the other routes you can take to access St. Vladimir while this closure is in effect.

To keep everyone safe during construction, the Project Team asks you to:

- Follow all signage and any site crew directions
- Drop children off from the passenger side of the vehicle
- Do not stop in driving lanes or crosswalks
