184 Street NW Bridge Rehabilitation

Rehabilitation of the 184 Street NW Bridge over Yellowhead Trail is scheduled to start the week of **August 10, 2026**. Rehabilitation of the bridge will ensure a safe and reliable crossing for all users. **A temporary full closure of the bridge is required to complete the rehabilitation safely.** Construction is anticipated to take approximately three months and will be completed in fall 2026.

Construction Details

- Removal of surface asphalt.
- Repairs to the concrete bridge deck.
- Upgraded waterproofing system.
- New asphalt.

Traffic Impacts and Access

- A temporary full closure of the bridge will be required in the summer of 2026. Closures are expected to begin on August 10. During closures, traffic will be rerouted to alternate routes to cross Yellowhead Trail, including Anthony Henday Drive and 170 Street.
- Access to businesses and nearby residential properties will be maintained.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout construction.
- Access to the ETS bus stops will be maintained.
- The ramps on and off Yellowhead Trail will remain open. Traffic entering 184 Street will be unable to cross the bridge, but can proceed north or south as shown on the attached graphic.

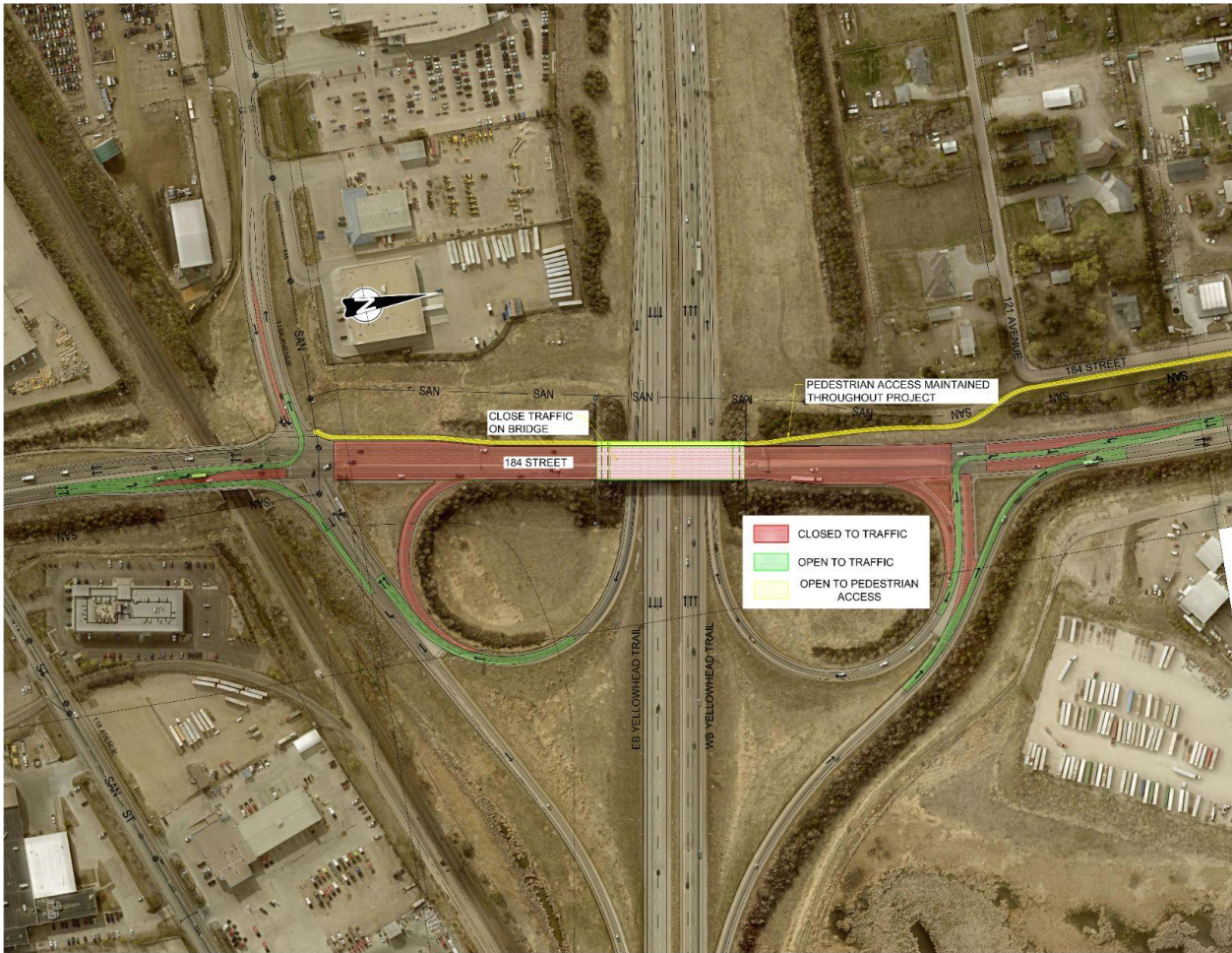


Image 1 - Construction limits
