Delayed: Lane closures on 170 Street approaching 95 Avenue

The planned northbound lane closures as part of the 95 Avenue Renewal project have been delayed by one week due to weather. Northbound lane reductions on the approach to the 170 Street and 95 Avenue intersection will now come into place the week of **June 29** and are scheduled to remain in place for a month while crews restore the roadway on the east side of the intersection. This delay is not anticipated to delay the overall project.

During select off-peak/overnight periods, an additional lane closure may be required to complete utility connections to a manhole located within the centre through lane along 170 Street.

Access

- The southside access at the 167 Street and 95 Avenue intersection will remain closed until July 2026.
- The southside eastbound lanes on 95 Avenue from 163 Avenue to 170 Avenue will remain closed until October 2026
- The northbound right turn lane on 170 Street will remain closed until fall 2026. Right turns onto 95 Avenue going northbound will still be allowed from the remaining open lanes.
- A temporary speed limit of 50 km/h will be in effect throughout the construction zone.

Motorists and pedestrians should expect delays and are encouraged to plan ahead and allow extra travel time when travelling through the area. Traffic restrictions are necessary to provide a safe work zone for crews and equipment. We appreciate the public's patience and cooperation while this work is completed.
