STATEMENT

Through the Privacy Directive, the City of Edmonton acknowledges the importance of protection of personal information within its custody or control. Privacy principles are not absolute. The City of Edmonton must balance the need to manage information in an open and transparent manner, and the need to respect and protect the privacy of those who work for it or have dealings with it. In some cases, a balance must be struck between privacy rights and public interests.

PURPOSE

To ensure the City of Edmonton is in compliance with the privacy provisions of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* and to establish commitment to the protection of all recorded personal information about an identifiable individual.

To ensure that whenever a system involving personal information is being developed or substantially changed, the City of Edmonton undertakes a Privacy Impact Assessment to analyse potential impacts on privacy and to ensure the City takes measures to make the system compliant with this directive

APPLICATION

PROCEDURE

The FOIP Head (the City Manager), on behalf of all Employees, has pledged that the City will collect, use, and disclose an individual's personal information only with that person's knowledge, consent or as required/permitted by law. All Employees are responsible for maintaining privacy and confidentiality of information in accordance with FOIP
