Missing Sidewalk Program: Argyll Road

The City of Edmonton will be constructing a new sidewalk along Argyll Road from 75 Street to 81 Street this summer as part of the Missing Sidewalk Program. The program focuses on filling in missing links in the pedestrian network, including retaining walls. Construction is anticipated to start at the end of July and be completed by the end of September 2026.

This project includes building a new sidewalk on the south side of Argyll Road to connect with existing paths. During construction, the south curb lane (eastbound) will be closed from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. to safely complete this work while also ensuring afternoon peak-hour traffic is not impacted. The two existing westbound lanes will not be affected.

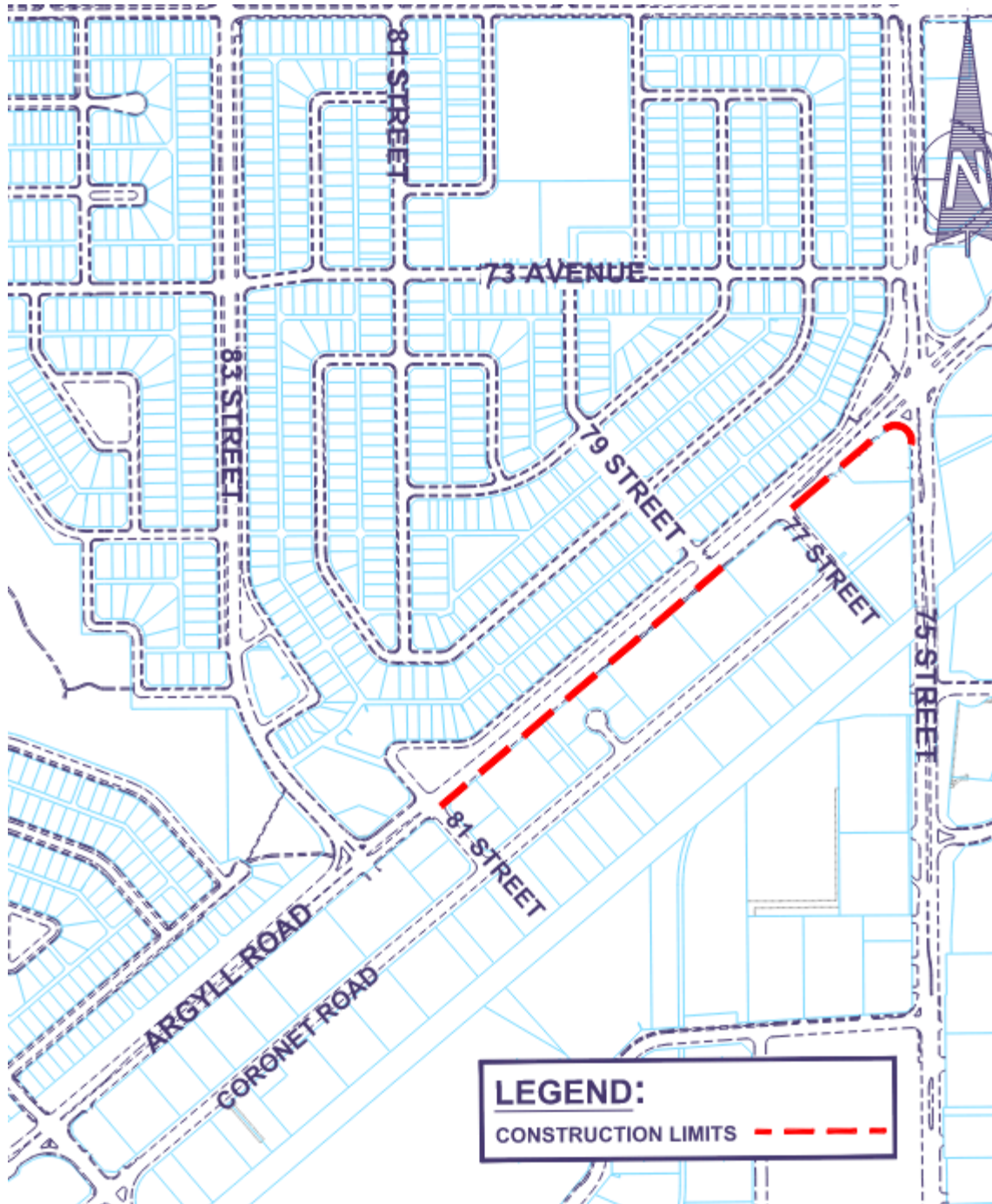


Image 1 - Map of construction limits and new sidewalk location
