Surveys

- + An online survey was available from February 18 – March 11, 2026
- + Paper copies of the survey and a survey drop box were available at a speakboard set up near the Beacon Heights Community League rinks

In-person drop-in event

- + A drop-in event was held on Saturday, March 7 from 11 a.m to 2 p.m at Beacon Heights School. This event provided an opportunity for community members to share feedback with the Project Team

- + Two bus tours were held during the in-person event so community members could tour Beacon Heights and share their feedback and ideas with the Project Team
