Edmonton City Council enacts:

PART I - INTERPRETATION

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| PURPOSE | 1 | The purpose of this bylaw is to establish Family and Community Support Services Advisory Committee as a council committee, and to establish its membership and mandate. |

PART II - MANDATE & MEMBERSHIP

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| MANDATE | 4 | <p>The mandate of the Family and Community Support Services Advisory Committee will be to provide advice and recommendations to Council and the City Manager, as appropriate, regarding:</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">(a) planning, application, review and assessment, award recommendations, and reporting for Family and Community Support Services and other community funding programs to ensure effective community investment; and</p> |
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- (b) opportunities for support, capacity building, and research within the social prevention and voluntary sectors to ensure City supports and resources are intentional, data-informed, and aligned with Council priorities.

MEMBERSHIP 5 The Family and Community Support Services Advisory Committee will be comprised of 13 members appointed by Council.

PART III - TRANSITION & REPEAL

TRANSITION 6 On the coming into force of this bylaw, members appointed to the Community Services Advisory Board will continue as members of the Family and Community Support Services Advisory Committee until the expiry of their current term.

TERM 7 The Community Services Advisory Board Bylaw, Bylaw 20672, is repealed.
