Upcoming Transit Service Adjustments in the Capilano and Gold Bar Neighbourhoods

As part of June 2026 service changes, ETS will replace conventional transit (Route 522) with On Demand Transit (ODT) in the Capilano and Gold Bar neighbourhoods. Transit ridership is relatively low in Capilano and Gold Bar, and ODT is a better fit for the neighbourhoods. ODT provides riders with direct service to a local transit hub when requested, instead of adhering to a fixed schedule and routing.

Capilano and Gold Bar Riders using ODT will have access to Capilano Mall Transit Centre as their transit hub, where they can pay their fare and transfer to regular ETS bus service.

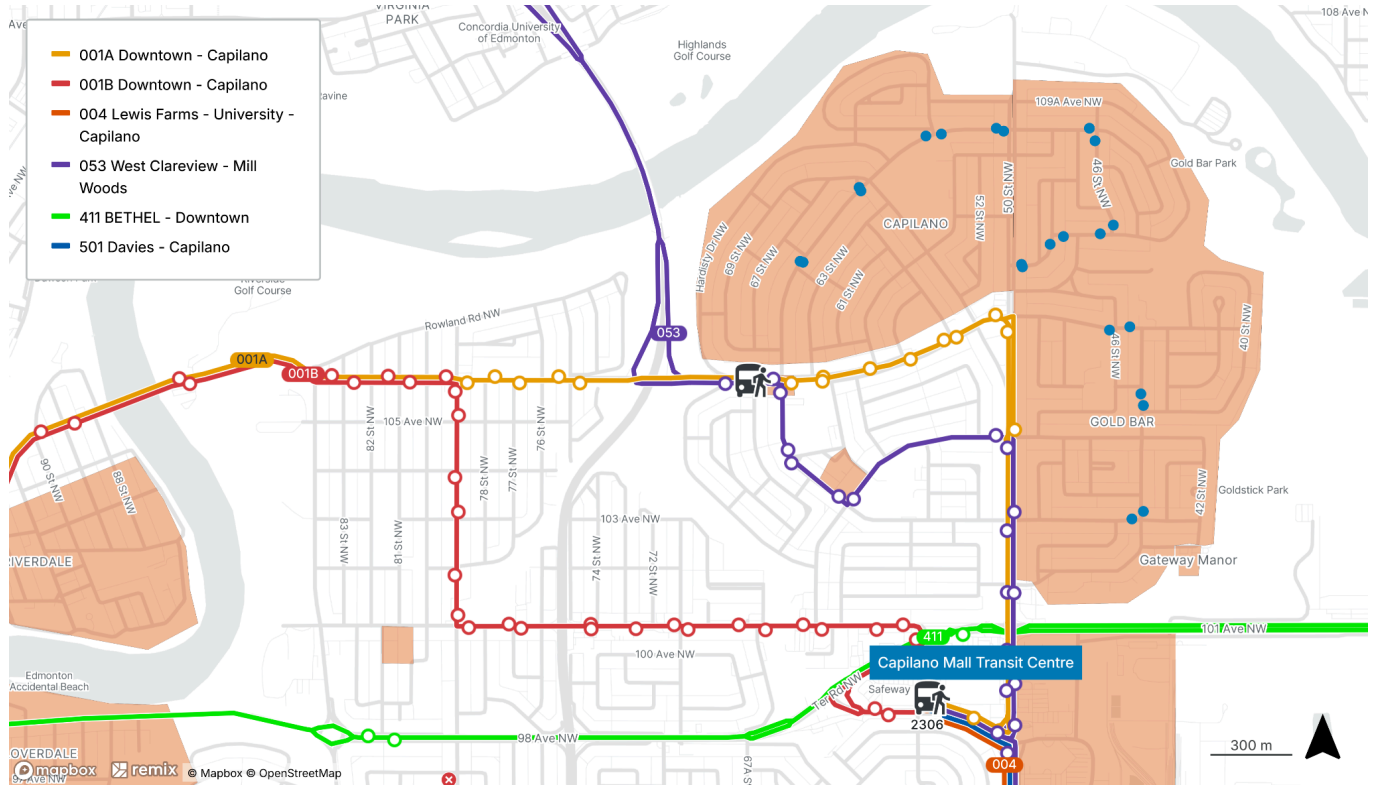

What is On Demand Transit?

On Demand Transit will use existing bus stops in Capilano and Gold Bar as shown on the map below. The On Demand bus will take you to Capilano Mall Transit Centre, or to a perimeter stop on 106 Ave where you can transfer to Routes 1A or 53. ODT buses are accessible for riders with limited mobility and include child-friendly seats.
