

Hazardous materials abatement to begin at the Coliseum site

In the coming weeks, hazardous materials abatement, which involves the identification and removal of hazardous substances, will begin at the Coliseum site (formerly known as Northlands Coliseum), located at 7424 118 Avenue NW. This preliminary work will prepare the site for deconstruction as part of the Coliseum Deconstruction and Site Redevelopment project.

Impacts of the work

While the upcoming abatement work is anticipated to have minimal impact on nearby residents and businesses, there may be increased noise levels and traffic. This work will take place between 7 a.m. and 9 p.m., Monday through Saturday, in accordance with Community Standards Bylaw 14600. Most of the abatement work will not be visible to the public, as it will be completed inside the building.

The City of Edmonton continues to work to reduce work-related impacts while keeping residents and businesses informed.

Once hazardous materials abatement is completed, deconstruction work is anticipated to begin. More information about deconstruction will be shared before the work begins.
