Dawson Bridge Rehabilitation

The City of Edmonton continues to make progress on the Dawson Bridge Rehabilitation project, with construction expected to be complete by the end of spring 2026.

To accommodate construction activities, a temporary single-lane closure will be in place on Dawson Bridge starting April 6 through to late April.

Traffic will be reduced to a single lane and controlled by temporary traffic signals on either side of the bridge. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

This work is part of the ongoing rehabilitation of Dawson Bridge to extend its lifespan and ensure it remains safe and reliable for all users.

Delays are expected, particularly during peak travel times. Motorists are encouraged to plan ahead and consider other routes where possible.

The City thanks residents and commuters for their patience and cooperation during construction.
