

Construction Notice

103A Avenue and 99 Street Pedway Project

On August 14, crews are working to reopen sections of 99 Street and 103A Avenue by the evening. This will allow the City Hall parkade to be accessible from 102A Avenue and 103A Avenue. **Some turn movements from 103A Avenue onto 99 Street will open in the coming days** as crews work to safely reopen the full intersection.

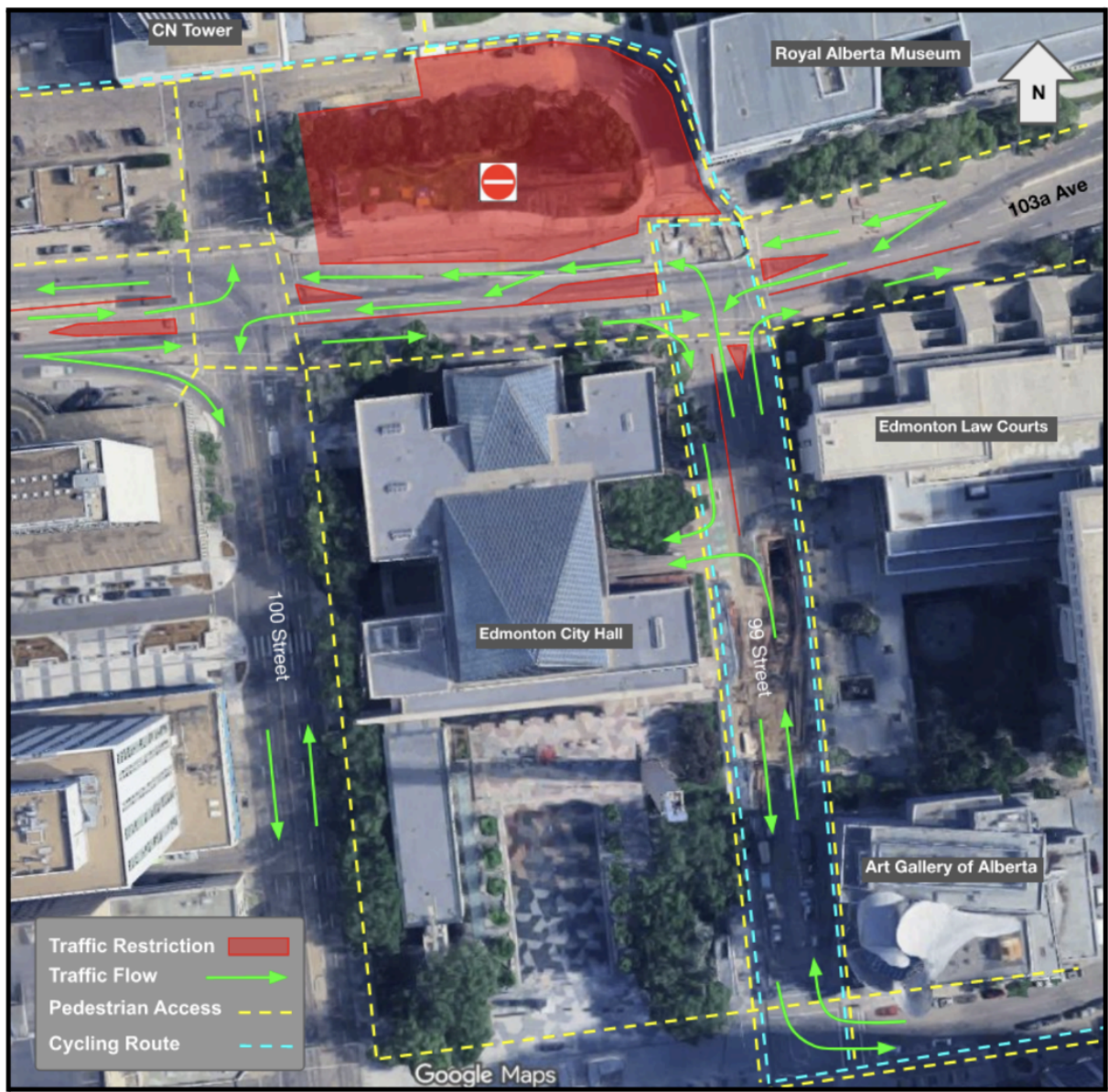
The bike lane on the west side of 99 Street will also reopen on August 14, except for a short section near the City Hall breezeway which is expected to open next week.

Access to the Royal Alberta Museum, including accessible drop-off and pick-up zones, will remain at the 97 Street entrance throughout construction.

In late fall, a portion of 99 Street at 102A Avenue will temporarily close for approximately one month for installation of a roadway contraction joint, which will temporarily change access into the City Hall parkade (access will be maintained from 103A Avenue).

The underground pedway will connect Churchill LRT Station to the Station Lands development north of 104 Avenue. The overall project is anticipated to be complete by the end of 2026.
