

Construction Notice – Piling work for Anthony Henday Drive LRT Bridge

Starting the **week of March 23**, Ledcor will begin installing driven concrete piles north of Anthony Henday Drive near 111 Street. These piles will eventually support the future Anthony Henday Drive LRT Bridge. **Significant noise, vibration and dust will be associated with the piling.**

This work is expected to last approximately **1 week** and will occur on weekdays between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Work may also occur on weekends between the same hours when required. Once piling is complete, the LRT bridge will continue to take shape over the next year, followed by the installation of track and LRT systems.

We thank nearby residents for their patience as we complete this important work for the future bridge. Please refer to the map below for details.

Other Impacts

- Heavy truck traffic will increase on 111 Street. No other traffic disruptions are expected during the work.
- Large equipment used for piling will include piling rigs, cranes and numerous trucks.
- Mitigation measures are in place to minimize disruptions as much as possible, and work will be monitored from safety, technical and environmental perspectives.
