

Duncan Innes Playground

June 2026

Playgrounds are a crucial part of Edmonton's neighbourhoods. Playgrounds foster play and encourage social interaction, exploration and imagination for residents of all ages. The City of Edmonton is renewing the playground in Duncan Innes to ensure it remains a vibrant, multi-generational hub for everyone in the community.

Project overview

As part of the renewal, the City will replace the existing play equipment. A rendering of the new playground equipment is available on the project web page, edmonton.ca/PlaygroundRenewal. New landscaping will include sod, a new park bench, a new "buddy" bench, new fence, concrete pads and pathway and a waste receptacle.

Construction impacts

Construction is anticipated to start in June and be complete in the fall of 2026. The tennis courts will remain open during construction.

To facilitate the new playground, walkway and benches, two tree removals are planned as part of this project (*circled in red in the image on the back*). The City of Edmonton values every tree and works closely with our Forestry colleagues when tree removals are necessary.

Residents in the neighbourhood may experience increased noise levels and construction vehicle and equipment traffic around the area. All construction will take place during the hours of 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday to Saturday, according to the Community Standards Bylaw. Construction equipment and materials will be stored near the work area.
