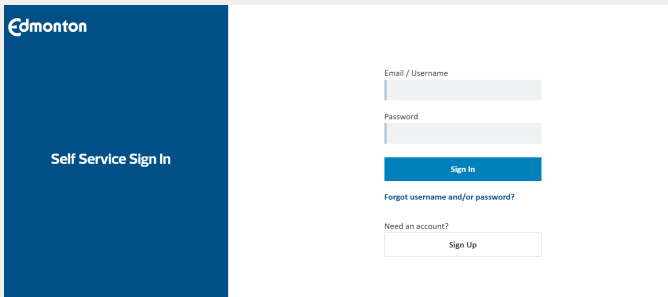

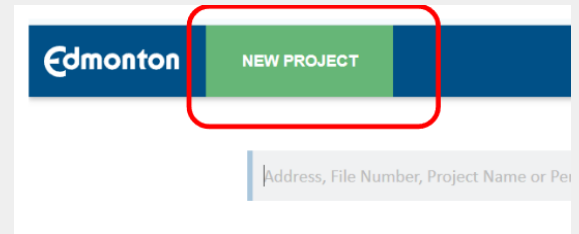

How To Apply for Annual Electrical Permits

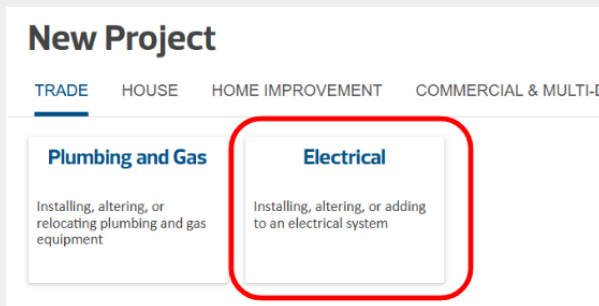
1. Log in at selfserve.edmonton.ca

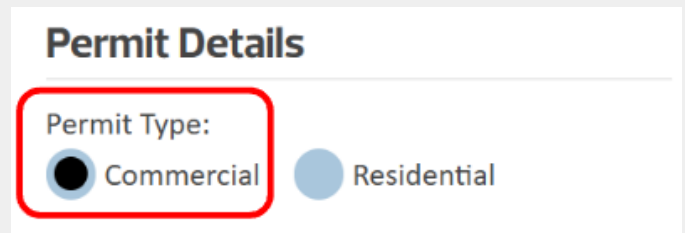
2. Select "New Project" at the top left

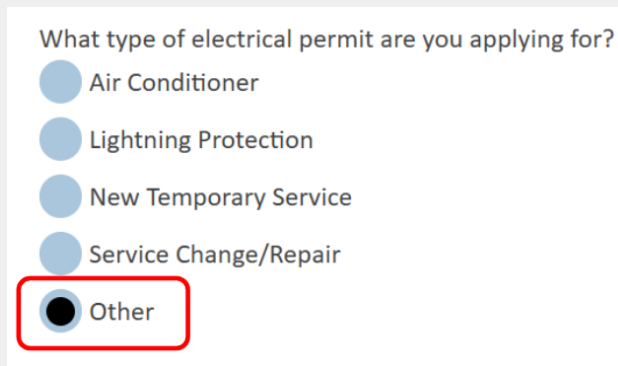
3. Select "Electrical"

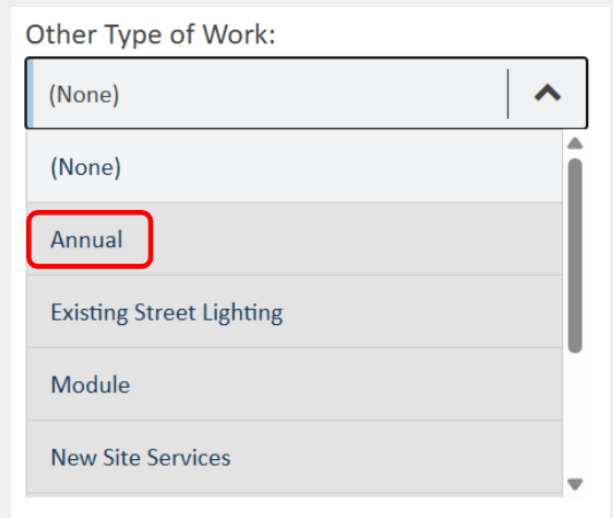
3. Select "Commercial"
