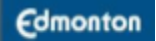

- Confirmation of final investment decision. May include a public media release or a formal letter, on the company's letterhead, from the head of the company.
- Estimated total annual net new carbon diversion or capture amount. Including detailed plans for connection to, and or extension of Alberta's Carbon Capture, Utilization, and Storage (CCUS) network.

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<sup>1</sup> Linear property is defined in section 284(1)(k) of the Municipal Government Act, and is further described in the Matters Relating to Assessment and Taxation Regulation. On this form, please include a description of any linear property integral to the project such that the property can be identified once it enters the regulatory process.
