CENTENNIAL GRANTS

Public Notice is hereby given that The City of Edmonton has applied to the Government of Alberta for approval to finance in part the Centennial Library with total eligible grants provided as assistance to municipalities under the Federal Provincial Centennial Grants Program.

As The City of Edmonton may consider a purely municipal grant to voluntary community organizations or individual citizens contemplating significant projects of a lasting nature notice is hereby given that applications for centennial grants from The City of Edmonton must be made in writing to the undersigned prior to May 1st, 1965.

Applications must contain a detailed plan of the proposed project, documentation on ability or means to finance and maintain the project, reasonable assurance of a completion date prior to or during the year 1967 and a summary of the services or benefits to the community envisioned by the completion of the project.

Only applications demonstrating a realistic need for financial assistance will be considered.

It should be noted that under no circumstances will a possible centennial grant from The City of Edmonton be allowed to exceed 20% of the total cost of the project.

Notice is hereby given that all centennial projects or activities scheduled to be carried out in the City of Edmonton prior to or during 1967 must be registered with the Civic Centennial Committee in order that a co-ordinated masterplan may be effectuated.

Registrations should be made in writing to the undersigned stating the nature, location and date of project or activity.
