Low Level Bridge Area Traffic Impacts

The City of Edmonton will complete paving and restoration work in the Low Level Bridge area, including the restoration of the approach roadways and line painting. Lane reductions and temporary full road closures are required from July 16 to July 20. Motorists should expect delays and plan alternate routes where possible. Some night work will take place to minimize disruptions.

Low Level Bridge area closures and lane reductions

From July 16 to 20, crews will remove and restore sections of the temporary paved detour in the Low Level Bridge area, including portions of Connors Road, Scona Road, Grierson Hill, McDougall Hill Road and bridge approaches. Traffic impacts will include (see map on reverse for visual):

- **July 16, 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.:** Single-lane closures on Connors Road, Scona Road and the northbound and southbound Low Level Bridges.
- **July 17, 8 p.m. to July 20, 4 a.m.:** Full closures of the northbound and southbound Low Level Bridges, including the portions of Connors Road and Scona Road approaching the bridges.
- Temporary off-peak full road closures during select construction activities.
- Temporary closures affecting portions of 98 Avenue, ETS roadways, the Grierson Hill access ramp and the cloverleaf connections between Grierson Hill road and McDougall Hill road.
- Both northbound and southbound traffic is recommended to detour using the James Macdonald Bridge.

Lane reductions and closures will occur during off-peak hours and will be removed during peak travel periods whenever possible.

99A Street closure

From July 17, 10 a.m. to July 20, 11 p.m., 99A Street will be closed between Scona Road and the Low Level Bridges. This closure is required to provide space for construction equipment and materials. Residential access will be maintained from the south via Scona Road. See map on the reverse side.
