

Meyonohk Playground Renewal

June 2026

Playgrounds are a crucial part of Edmonton's neighbourhoods. Playgrounds foster play and encourage social interaction, exploration and imagination for residents of all ages. The City of Edmonton is renewing the playground in Meyonohk Park to ensure it remains a vibrant, multi-generational hub for everyone in the community.

Project overview

Through this project, the City of Edmonton will:

- Remove existing playground equipment and the sand play base
- Install new playground equipment
- Install new surfacing for better accessibility
- Replace existing concrete next to the playground
- Replace existing furniture surrounding the playground with five new benches and two picnic tables
- Renew two bike racks
- Remove the concrete pad to the north of the playground and replace it with grass

Construction impacts

Construction is anticipated to start the first week of June and be completed in the fall of 2026. The construction area will be fenced. The rest of Meyonohk Park will remain open during construction. *(Please see the map on the other side of this bulletin.)*

Residents in the neighbourhood may experience increased noise levels and construction vehicle and equipment traffic around the area. All construction will take place during the hours of 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday to Saturday, according to the Community Standards Bylaw. Construction equipment and materials will be stored near the work area.
