

Riverside Golf Course Renewal

April 2026

To ensure the Riverside Golf Course remains a safe and accessible amenity for years to come, the City of Edmonton is performing renewal work.

As part of the Riverside Golf Course Renewal Project, the project team will complete an overhaul of the course's irrigation system, including EPCOR work to upgrade the water main from Rowland Road, construction of a new pumphouse and all other associated irrigation components for each hole of the golf course.

The City will also reconfigure the cart path from the Hole 8 green to the Hole 9 tee, the green and fairway at Hole 5 and the cart storage/staging area next to the clubhouse.

Construction schedule

Construction is set to begin in the summer and is expected to be complete by the end of 2026.

Closures and detours

Specific holes will be closed at a time, allowing the majority of the golf course to remain open during construction. The clubhouse and all facility buildings will retain public access during construction. Closure and construction updates will be shared with golfers by the Riverside Golf Course team.

Tree removals

To complete the project, several trees must be removed before construction starts in the spring. The project will be adding a handful of trees to select areas of the golf course.

The City values every single tree, and removals are guided by the City's Corporate Tree Policy C456C and Public Tree Bylaw 18825, which prioritize the preservation and protection of trees by ensuring equitable compensation for the canopy loss. All trees will be examined for possible impacts to wildlife before removal.

The park website, edmonton.ca/RiversideGolf, will be updated as construction progresses.
