



## Wagner Road Upgrades

January 2026

This is an update for Edmontonians who travel along Wagner Road. The City is currently delivering two improvement projects on Wagner Road: a new Active Transportation Network Expansion Program route and a Towards 40 project.

### Active Transportation Network Expansion Program

Edmonton's active transportation network provides safe and direct options for commuting, running errands, accessing parks and enjoying the river valley for those who walk, cycle and roll. As part of the Active Transportation Network Expansion Program, the City has developed a connection along Wagner Road from 75 Street to 86 Street. This route provides an east-west connection between the 75 Street shared pathway and the 86 Street shared pathway. The new Wagner Road shared pathway also offers a more complete active transportation connection to the Davies LRT station and W.P. Wagner High School.

### Towards 40

The Towards 40 program is focused on improving road safety in areas where speeding and safety issues have been identified. It encourages safe driving habits and increases speed limit compliance using adaptable traffic calming measures.

### Project Update and Next Steps

Installation of the active transportation network route along Wagner Road is ongoing as the project team works to ensure the new infrastructure meets quality standards and design requirements. The project team and the contractor will review the project site in spring 2026 to assess and complete the remaining work. In the meantime, the route is open and safe for use.
