Transit priority improvements on 101 Street

Starting the week of August 24, the City of Edmonton will install transit priority measures on 101 Street between Jasper Avenue and 102A Avenue. Construction is expected to take approximately one week.

These improvements will help buses move more efficiently and reliably while improving safety for everyone using the corridor. The project will reduce transit delays, address congestion, support growing transit demand and create curb lanes that meet modern transit standards.

Permanent changes

101 Street between Jasper Avenue and 102A Avenue northbound will be reduced from three to two lanes to accommodate new wider traffic lanes that align with current standards.

The following changes will be in effect from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Friday:

- Southbound bus-only curb lane (right turns permitted).
- No on-street parking or loading in either direction. Alternative loading and parking is available on adjacent streets.

Construction details

Work includes:

- Traffic signal upgrades to improve turning movements and pedestrian crossings.
- Removal of one northbound travel lane to create wider curb lanes.
- Road resurfacing, new pavement markings and updated signage.
- Most work will take place overnight from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. and 9 p.m. to 9 a.m. on weekends. This work is noise bylaw exempt.
- When possible, lane closures will be removed during peak travel periods.

Access

- One lane will remain open in each direction throughout construction. Motorists and pedestrians should expect delays.
- Access to businesses and properties will be maintained.
- There will be no impacts to ETS service.
- Nearby residents can expect some construction noise during overnight work.
