

WINDERMERE DISTRICT PARK

July 2026

Construction on the City of Edmonton's new Windermere District Park is set to begin in August. District parks are designed to meet the needs of multiple communities and are important for Edmontonians' health, wellness and quality of life.

Project overview

This project will prepare the site with base-level amenities to support the needs of two future schools, a recreation facility and a transit facility. At this point, the project includes construction on the open space elements of the site only, not any of the facilities.

Construction phasing

Construction on Windermere District Park will be completed in two phases. Phase 1 is scheduled to start the second week of August, weather permitting. This phase will be completed alongside the province's project to build a public school.

As part of Phase 1, crews will build the:

- Cricket field
- Soccer field
- Baseball diamond
- Combination field
- Picnic area
- Seating node

Phase 1 will also include tree and shrub planting as well as sod in the open spaces.

Phase 1 is scheduled to be complete in fall 2028. Construction timing for Phase 2 will be announced when more information is available.

Residents in the neighbourhood may experience increased noise levels and traffic around the area. All construction will take place between the hours of 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday to Saturday, according to the Community Standards Bylaw. Construction equipment and materials will be stored near the work area.
