


From the exterior, this roof structure becomes a **Light Turbine**. This Turbine is influenced from both the interior and the exterior of the project. It represents the physical energy being expended in the fitness areas contained within its envelope. From the outside, it reflects the changes in the exterior environment both throughout the day and over the reasons. The Turbine was one of the primary architectural pieces that evolved as the envelope of the project was developed through Design Development, yet it has remained true to the original design sketches.









VIEW FROM ROSENTHAL WAY WITH URBAN PLAZA
















