
Project Objectives




Local Road (9.0 m)



Arterial Road (min 13.9 m)




What We Heard

- Access concerns





Collision Analysis


Collisions by Top 5 Causes



- ❖There were 251 collisions along the corridor between 2010 and 2014
- ❖The cause of approximately 45% of collisions is "followed too closely"




Traffic Analysis




Analysis software

- Existing traffic volumes and future growth analyzed
- Traffic signal phasing at 97 Street and 82 Street optimized to improve traffic flow


Highlights of Proposed Plan


Proposed: 11.5m

- Wider boulevard on north side
- Narrow roadway for speed compliance


Existing: 13.5m

- Larger crossing distance for peds
- Wide roadway allows speeding







97 Street Intersection Improvements

Crossing Improvements



Curb Extensions at 89 Street

Curb Extensions reduce the crossing distance for pedestrians and slow vehicles down at crossing locations

Curb Extensions are proposed at locations with higher volumes of pedestrian activity:

- 105 Street -83 Street


- 89 Street -81 Street

- 85 Street

82 Street to Fort Road Options


Option A (11.5m):

- Curb line sidewalk on north side
- Parking on both sides



Option B (10.2m):

- Boulevard sidewalk on north side
- No parking on north side



Summary of Proposed Improvements

- Roadway will be repaved, and sidewalks/streetlights will be replaced
- ❖ Roadway will be narrowed to 11.5m from 13.5m to increase north side boulevard
- Mature trees will not be impacted and new trees will be planted where possible
- Sidewalk will be added on north side between 82 Street and Fort Road
- Intersection improvements at 82 Street and 97 Street and curb extensions at various locations



Next Steps

- 1. Refine concept plan based on tonight's feedback.
- 2. Finalize and share the recommended plan by early 2016
- 3. Preliminary/Detailed Design phase 2016-2017.
- Tentative schedule for construction 2017-2018.
