# Project Considerations Under Review

- Increasing the road width
- Installing curbs and gutters
- Adding a boulevard and sidewalk along the south side of the avenue
- Upgrading light poles and changing lights to LED
- Removing trees and adding landscaping
- Relocating and installing utilities under the road (drainage, water, sanitary)
- Coordinating with CN Rail to install a new warning system for rail crossing (with crossing arms)

Future CN Rail crossing—will include a new warning system with crossing arms at 162 Avenue. No more whistles!



Future look of 162 Avenue (east)—will be constructed to the same standard as 162 Avenue (west).
