What We Heard

Poor drainage on the SW corner of 89 Street/123 Avenue

Standard Practice

• The detail design addresses drainage problems along roadways. If required, a new catch basin will be installed.



BRINGING OUR CITY VISION TO LIFE

What We Heard

• Insufficient lighting on 123 Avenue between 89 Street

and 90 Street

Standard Practice

- The new lighting design was developed in accordance with City Policy C564 to improve lighting levels.
- The new LED lighting design provides more uniform lighting along the roadway.



What We Heard

Speeding and traffic violations along 124 Avenue

Standard Practice

- All intersections within the neighbourhood will have traffic control measures installed after reconstruction is complete.
- The Office of Traffic Safety, community leagues, and the Edmonton Police Service manage neighbourhood speed issues through a cooperative effort.

What We Heard

Replace the existing noise wall because it is unfriendly

and ugly

Investigation/Outcome

- The existing noise wall functions well; replacing it is not planned at this time.
- Proposed closure to match existing colour.

What We Heard

- Building Great Neighbourhoods Program
 - Improve lighting at the park on 124 Avenue between 96 Street and 95A Street
 - Plant trees along 123 Avenue from 90 Street to 97 Street
 - Plant trees along 124 Avenue
