
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NORTH GLENORA NEIGHBOURHOOD RENEWAL PROGRAM

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Condition & Reconstruction Scope

- Age: +50 years (1953-62)
- Pavement: poor/fair condition
- Concrete: poor condition
- Surface works \$18 Million (conceptual)
- Includes replacement of pavement, sidewalk, curb and gutter, street lighting
- Does NOT include alleys or arterial roadways



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Design Considerations

Active Modes

 Addressing accessibility issues by providing new sidewalk/trail connections

Intersections

 Adding curb ramps, improving curb radius, and improving the overall operation





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Design Considerations

Road Width

 Where possible, roads are sized to current standards Collector = 11.5 m Local = 9.0 m

Curb Type

- Roll face curb
- Straight face curb





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Active Transportation

Improve infrastructure


- Sidewalks: In residential neighbourhoods, ensure accessibility to all bus stops and provide a sidewalk on at least one side of the street.
- Bicycle routes: Use the Bicycle
 Transportation Plan to
 implement bike lanes, shared use lanes and shared-use
 pathways.




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Active Transportation

- New sidewalk to bus stop along 142 Street from 109B Avenue
- New shared-use path along 109 Avenue in front of Coronation School







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Active Transportation

 New sidewalk along west side of 135 Street






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Active Transportation

Bus Stop Pads

- Reconstructed bus pad along 109B Ave will impact one tree
- Assessed value of this tree will be replanted in the neighbourhood



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Intersection Improvements

- Curb extension at 139 Street/ 109A Avenue (in front of Coronation School)
 - Reduce pedestrian crossing distance
 - Improve pedestrian safety
- Triangle island/Right turn bays:
 - Improve sightlines for vehicles
 - Improve intersection operation
 - Reduce pedestrian crossing distance






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Intersection Improvements

- 139 Street/109A Avenue/ 109B Avenue
 - Improve intersection operation
 - Improve sightlines





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Intersection Improvements

- 135 Street/109A Avenue
 - Reduce speeds by tightening corner
 - Eliminate yielding conflicts
 - Improve intersection safety






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Road Width Upgrades

- 139 Street 107 Avenue to
 109 Avenue
 - Currently 11.5 m, which is wider than City standards for a local roadway.
 - Will be reduced to 9 m to adhere to current City standards.
 - Will provide more green space and room for mature trees to grow.



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Curb Design

- Straight face curb
 - Collector roadways
 - Bus routes
 - School areas
 - Park areas
 - Roll faced curbs
 - Local roadways





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Streetlight Design Standards

Neighbourhood streetlight system

 Upgraded to energy efficient LED lighting, the new City standard for streetlights.



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Construction Staging

- Staged over two years (2013-14)
- Ultimate staging dependant on weather conditions, coordination with utilities, and unforeseen design and construction issues.
- To create minimal disturbance for students, construction activities around the schools will be scheduled during the summer months.
