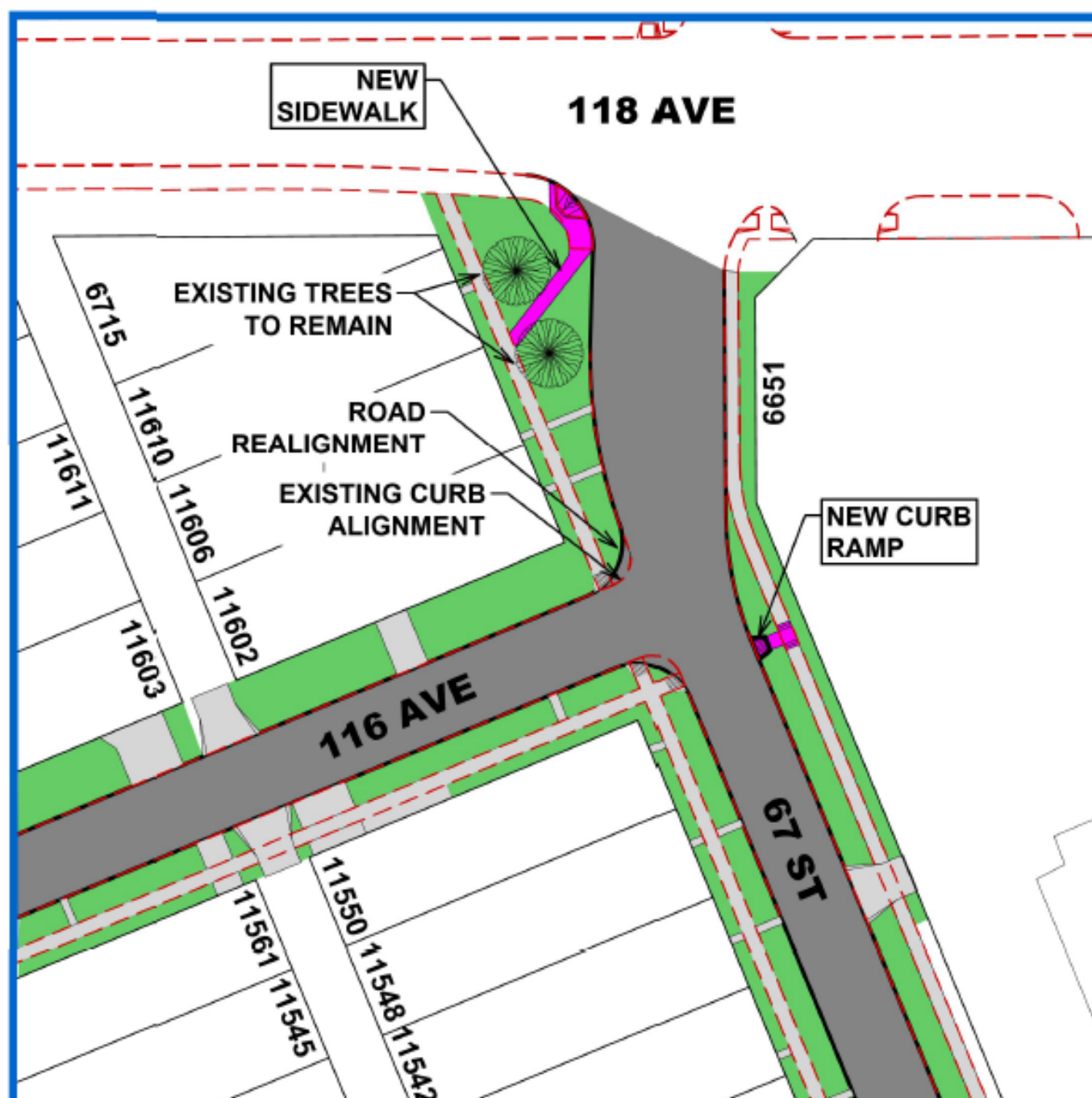


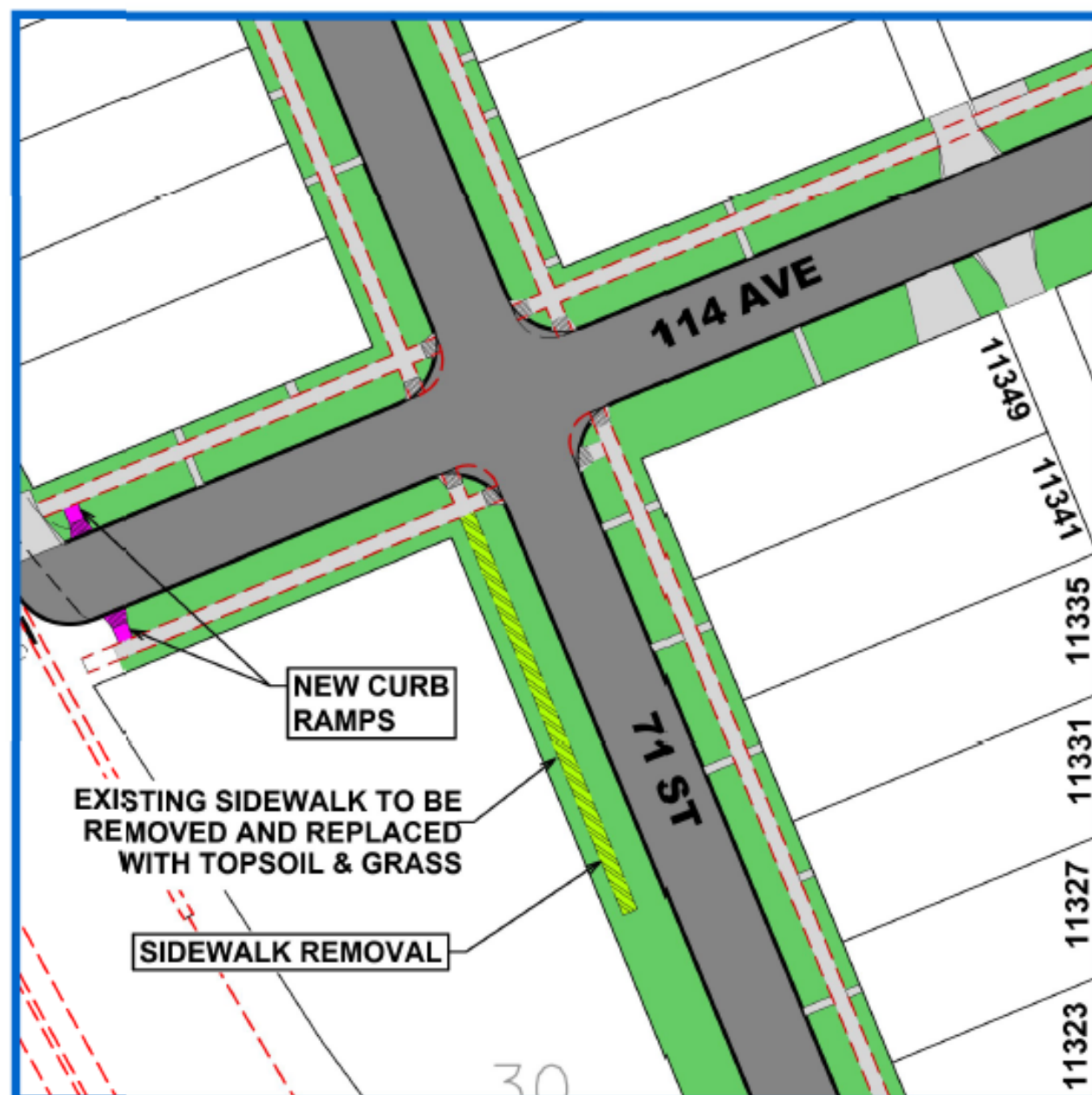
Sidewalks/ Roadway Modifications

BELLEVUE



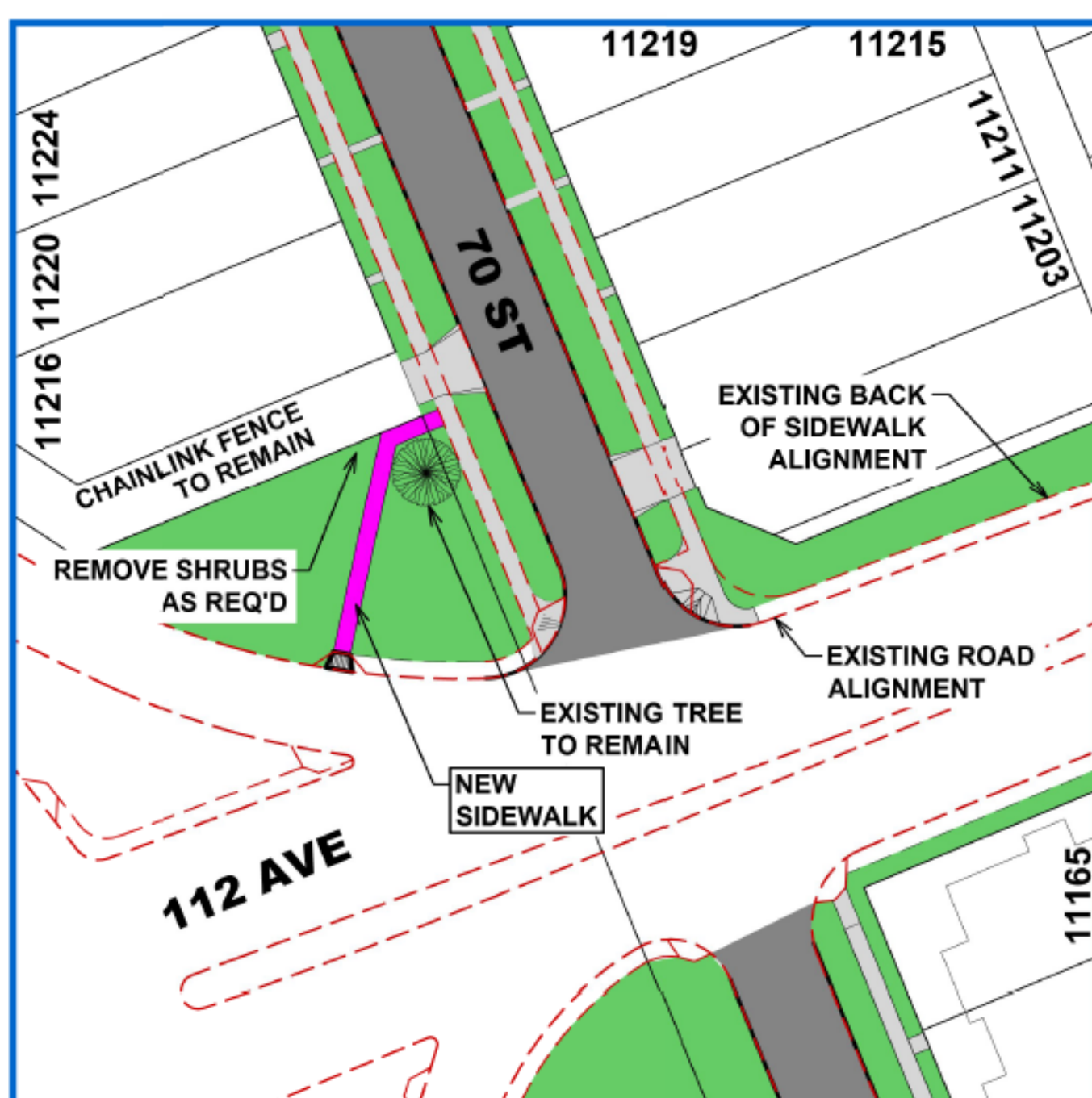
67 Street South of 118 Avenue

- New sidewalk connection from 118 Avenue to sidewalk on west boulevard of 67 Street
- Existing trees to remain



71 Street South of 114 Avenue

- Existing sidewalk to be removed and replaced with grass



70 Street & 112 Avenue

- New sidewalk between 70 Street & 112 Avenue
- Shrub removal as required

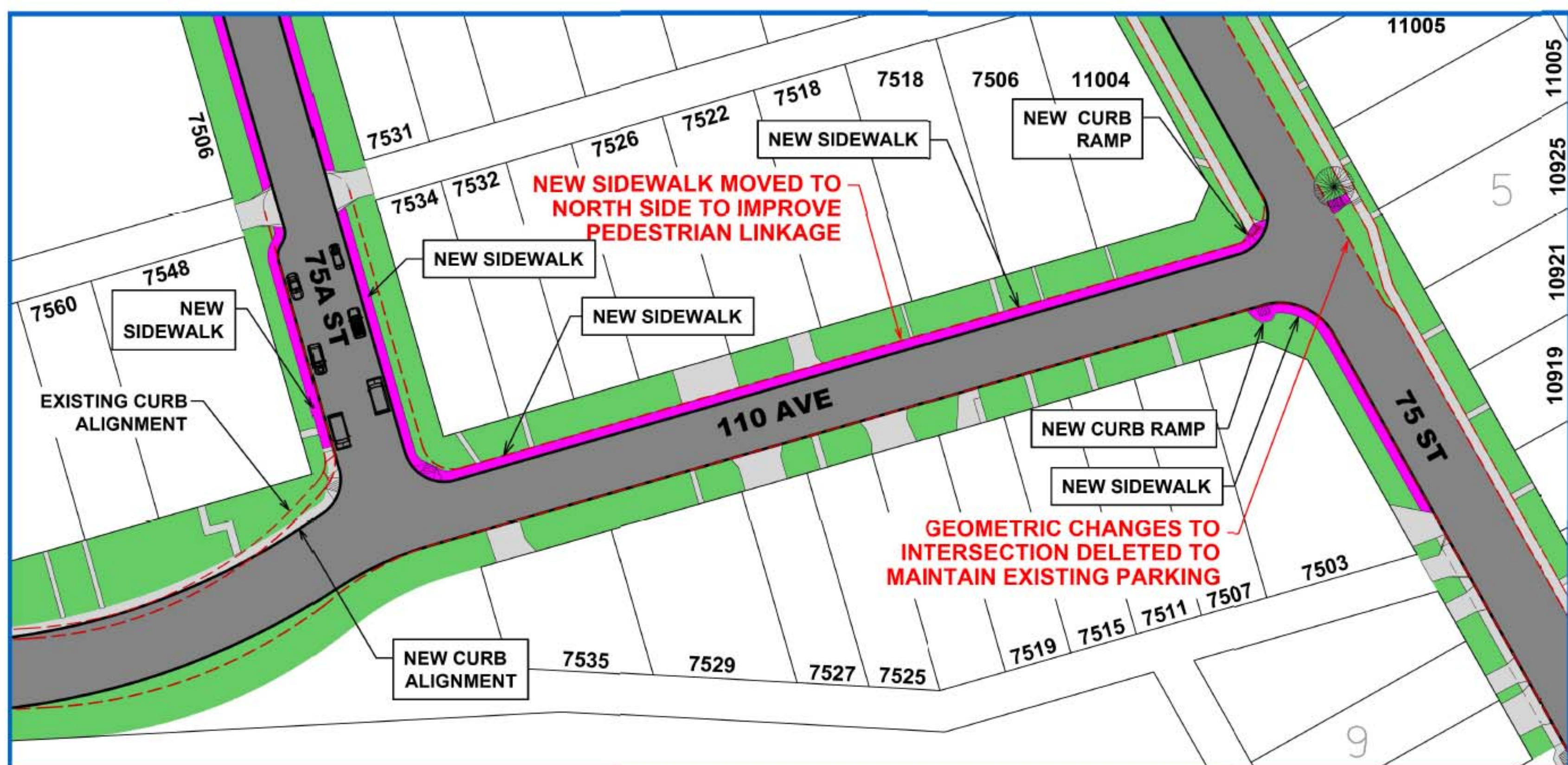
VIRGINIA PARK

Construction costs for new sidewalks are paid for by the city



109 Avenue

- **New drop off pad for Virginia Park Elementary School**
- **New sidewalk on south side of 109 Avenue between 73 Street & 74 Street**



75 Street

- **Bump-out on 75 Street at 110 Avenue proposed in previous meeting has been removed following community feedback**

75A Street

- **New sidewalk along both sides of 75A Street between 110 Avenue & 111 Avenue to provide pedestrian connectivity & missing sidewalk links**
- **East boulevard narrowed south of alley to add sidewalk**

110 Avenue

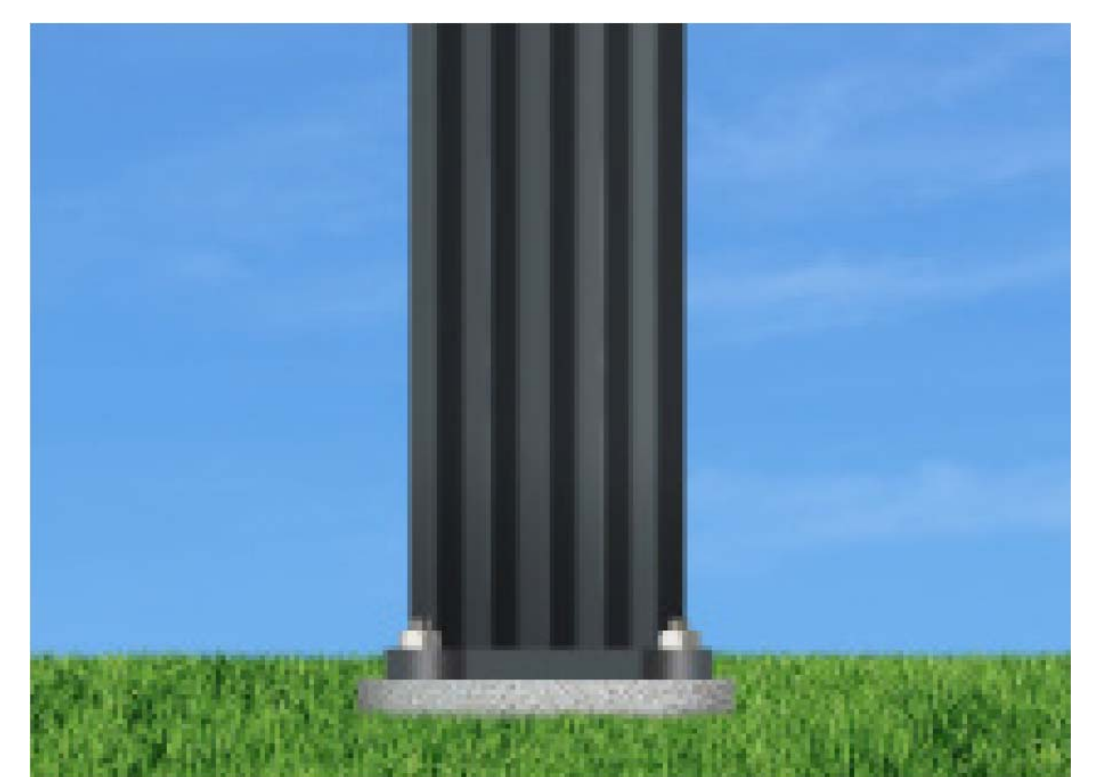
- **Sidewalk on south side of 110 Avenue proposed in previous meeting has been relocated to the north side of 110 Avenue to create continuous pedestrian corridor between 75 Street & 75A Street**
- **110 Avenue roadway width narrowed slightly between 75 Street and 75A Street to accomodate new sidewalk on north side but is not expected to impact operation of the roadway**
- **New curb alignment on 110 Avenue west of 75A Street to create safer intersection alignment**

Streetlight Design

- The decorative streetlighting local improvement was successful and will be proceeding in both Bellevue and Virginia Park neighbourhoods
- There was enough community support during the Expression of Interest in the Fall of 2017



- Bellevue Neighbourhood chose the Black Fluted pole with the Heritage Arm.



- Virginia Park Neighbourhood chose the Black Octagonal pole with the Heritage Arm
